

WINSIDE ROY REED POST #252 MEETING  
AUGUST 6, 2013

Bud Neel read the minutes of the July meeting. The minutes did not have information about the Immanuel Cemetery flagpole approval. Information from members was Brian P had moved and Stan S. seconded, motion carried to install a flagpole at the Immanuel Cemetery. Brian P. moved to approve the July minutes with the correction, Stan S. seconded, carried.

Assistant Treasurer Ray Jacobsen gave the treasurer's report and provided a copy to adjutant. Brian P. moved to approve the report, Dan Jaeger seconded, motion passed.

Committee reports:

Pitch tournament for PRIDE is moved to Saturday, September 28, 2013. Liquor license applied for and has been to Village board meeting for approval. The cost of the license application is \$40.00. Brian Petzoldt moved to pay the \$40.00 license fee, Dave Bloomfield seconded, carried.

Ray Jacobsen reported Nancy Jensen had sold over 400 tickets for Legion annual raffle. Ray asked if we could do anything for her. Ray Jacobsen moved to give her 10% of what she sold or \$40.00, Butch Edwards seconded, carried.

Discussion was held on the flagpoles at the Winside cemetery. Dan and Daryl volunteered to be committee to check on cemetery and report back about how many more poles we could erect along the East side, between the trees.
